AUTO REPAIR REFERENCE CENTER -

Automotive repair information from Chilton's manuals from 1945 - present. Available in all branches or via the Library's website.

ALLDATA ONLINE - Vehicle shop manuals online for car and light truck models back to 1982. Includes technical service bulletins and many diagrams. Available at Guildford and City Centre Libraries.

EBSCO - Articles from thousands of magazines including Consumer Reports, Automotive News, Popular Mechanics, Motor Age and more. Available in all branches or on the Library's website.

<u>Websites</u> - At <u>www.surreylibraries.ca/auto</u>, there are links to vehicle information on selected consumer and automotive websites, such as ConsumerSearch and CarProof.

Buying Guides

<u>Consumer Reports</u> - Magazines and books road test many vehicle models and track repairs long-term through a "trouble and cost index". Available at all branches or online from the library's website at <u>www.surreylibraries.ca/auto</u>

<u>Gold Book</u> - Lists up-to-date average regional used prices for all vehicles sold in Canada back to 1980 model year. Available at several branches for in- library use.

<u>Lemon-Aid</u> - A series of books with critical assessments of Canadian new and used vehicles; how to get the best buy and the best servicing. Available at all branches for in- library use or loan.

Manuals

<u>Repair Manuals</u> - selected repair manuals available for loan and for in library use at all branches. Look in the library catalogue, or on the shelves under 629.28.

<u>Vehicle Shop Manuals</u> - Official manufacturer's repair and maintenance publications, as used by factory technicians. Include troubleshooting charts, many diagrams, and diagnostic codes. Covers many car and light truck models from 1980 to 1994. For in- library use at City Centre only. Not listed in library catalogue - contact staff for assistance.
