Computer Hardware

- Any part of the computer system that you can see or touch.
- Peripherals: any piece of hardware attached to a computer.
 - Mouse
 - Keyboard
 - Printer
 - Web-Cam

Computer Software

or just software, is a collection of computer programs and related data that provide the instructions telling a computer what to do and how to do it.

Operating System Software or (OS)

- Controls the overall activity of the computer:
 - Windows XP, Windows 98, Vista, Windows 7, Mac OS etc.
 - The computer you are using right now is running the Windows 7 operating system.







Application Software

- Allows you to accomplish specific tasks.
 - Microsoft Word, Excel etc.







Storage devices:

- □ Hard drive (GB TB)
- CD/ DVD drive (700 MB/4.7-15 GB)
- □ USB flash drive (128 MB 64 GB)
