Connect Online with Voice and Video

There are many services available that allow you to make voice and video calls for free over a Wi-Fi connection including: Skype, WhatsApp, Facetime, and Google Hangout. It can be challenging to choose the service that is right for you. A good rule of thumb is to use the service that the least tech-comfortable person in your family or circle of friends prefers.

All four services

- Require a high-speed Internet connection to work
- Use cellular data when not on a wireless network
- Require speakers and microphone (either built-in to your device or separate)
- Require a webcam (either built-in or separate) to make video calls
- Cannot be used to call 911 or other emergency services

- FREE way to make calls within Canada and the US
- Can be used on desktop computers, smart phones, and other mobile devices
- Can be used to make phone calls, video calls, group calls
- Data is encrypted in transit only; this means Google has access to your data




WhatsApp

What does the status "Hey there! I am using WhatsApp." mean?







Facetime

To start a **Facetime** call, simply enter the name, email address, or phone number of the iOS user you'd like to Facetime.


Is this contact on an **Apple device**? How can you tell?
