


E-BOOKS FOR KIDS!

1. **FIRST OF ALL:**



You'll need a free Adobe ID to authorize your device/software. Head over to [Adobe.com](#) and click on Sign In (in the upper right corner). Scroll down and click on "Don't Have an Adobe ID?" to create one.




2. If you have a iPod, a smartphone or a tablet, make sure your wi-fi is on and go to the Apple [App Store](#) or the Android [Play Store](#) and:

INSTALL THE OVERDRIVE APP

OR, if you have a computer, laptop, or regular e-reader:

INSTALL ADOBE DIGITAL EDITIONS

onto your computer or laptop and read e-books on there. Or use ADE to transfer e-books over to your e-reader. Get it at adobe.com



3. **GET AUTHORIZED**

Grab that Adobe ID you made in Step #1 and authorize your app/software.


Smartphone/tablet/iPod users will need to authorize their OverDrive app (in the app Settings menu).

e-Reader/computer users will need to authorize their Adobe Digital Editions software (in the Help menu, click on Authorize Computer).

4. LIBRARY TO GO


Smartphone/tablet/iPod users:
Jump into the OverDrive menu and Add a Library. Browse to find Canada > British Columbia > Thompson-Nicola Regional District Library and tap on British Columbia Libraries to get to the online catalog. Tap on Sign In, find the Thompson-Nicola Regional District Library System and then enter your library card barcode number. Tap the Sign In button.

e-Reader users:
Point a browser to
<http://downloads.bclibrary.ca> to access the catalog. Click on Sign In or Account in the upper right corner. Find the Thompson-Nicola Regional District Library System from the drop-down list, and then enter your library card barcode number. Click the Sign In button.



SEARCH

You can search by specific title or author, but to just browse through all the picture books: click on Advanced Search in the upper right corner of the Library To Go page. Leave Title / Author fields blank and select Picture Books Fiction / Nonfiction from the All Subjects drop-down menu. Click on the Search button.



DOWNLOAD

When you've found an available title, tap or click on the cover to enter the individual book page. There will be a large **Borrow** button. Clicking on that will move the book into your online Bookshelf where you can click on Download to transfer it to your computer or device.

If you are using the OverDrive app, the book will download to your OverDrive app Bookshelf and you can read it there. (If possible, make sure you're on wi-fi so you don't use up your data!)

If you are using a computer and your browser asks if you want to save or open the file you are downloading, choose Open and the book should open in Adobe Digital Editions. You can read it there or transfer it from there to an e-reader.

HOLDS

If the book you want is already checked out to someone else, you can get in line for it by placing a Hold. When your hold is ready for to read, you will get an email notification. After that, you'll have 3 days to check out your book before it gets passed on to the next person.

AND MORE:

-There is unlimited access to classics (such as vintage nursery rhyme books and fairy tale collections, etc) in the separate Always Available section of Library To Go. These titles never expire and don't count against your 5 item limit.

-Finished your book? You can return titles early from your device or computer.

-Need more time? The option to renew a title will appear in your account 3 days before your item expires.

-Even more e-books (including audio books, animated books, puzzles, games, language learning, and videos) are available through the library website. Check out the Online Resources - E-Books section of tnrdlib.ca and click on Sesame Street E-books or TumbleBooks to access our subscriptions.

HELP


Help is available from the following:
